






PCOA PERFORMANCE: 4-YEAR TREND

PCOA Total Scores: 4-Year Trend (2017—2020)




NAPLEX PERFORMANCE: 4-YEAR TREND

(First-time Pass Rates (%) for 2017—2020 Graduates)




MPJE PERFORMANCE: 4-YEAR TREND




