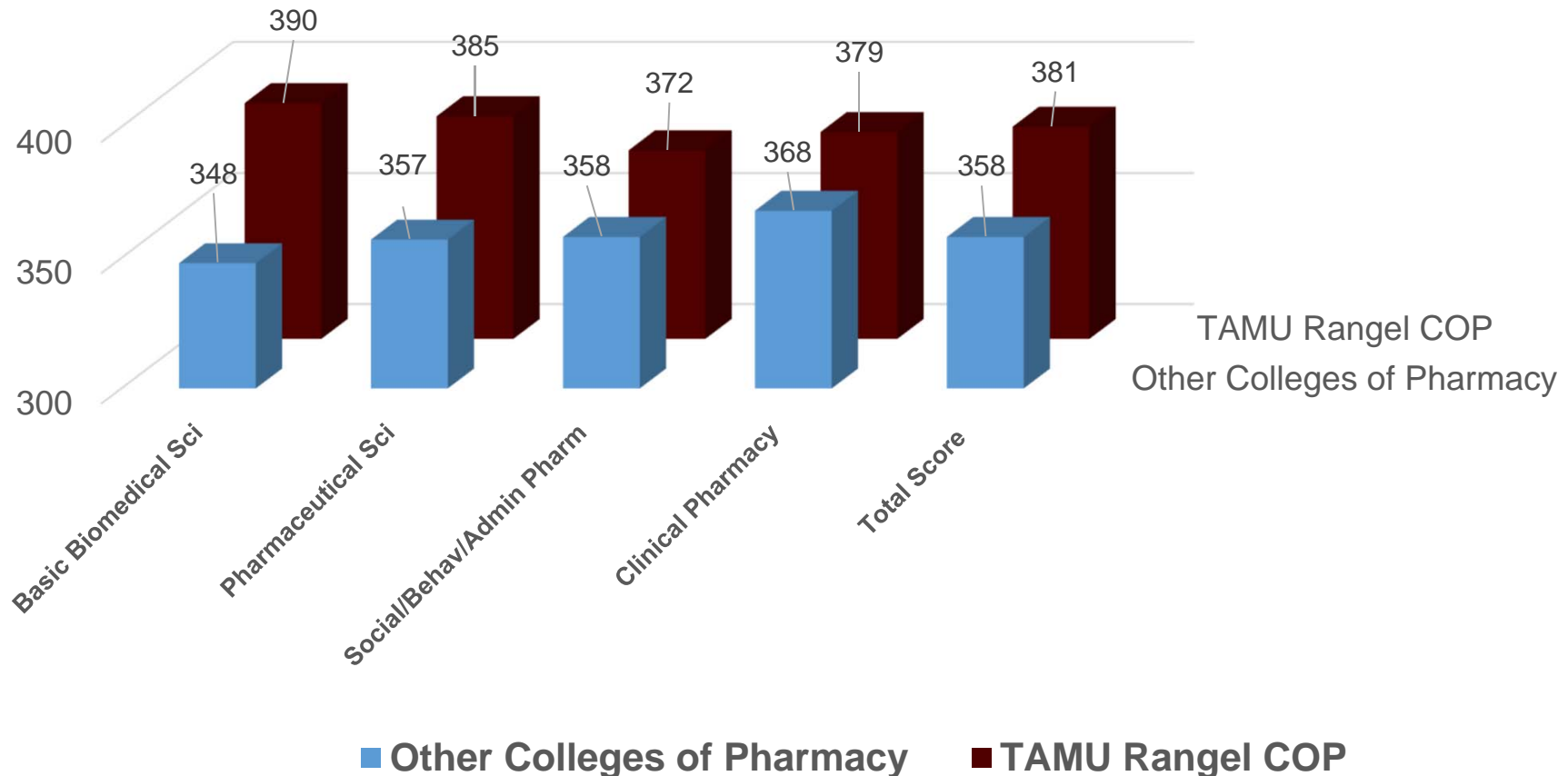

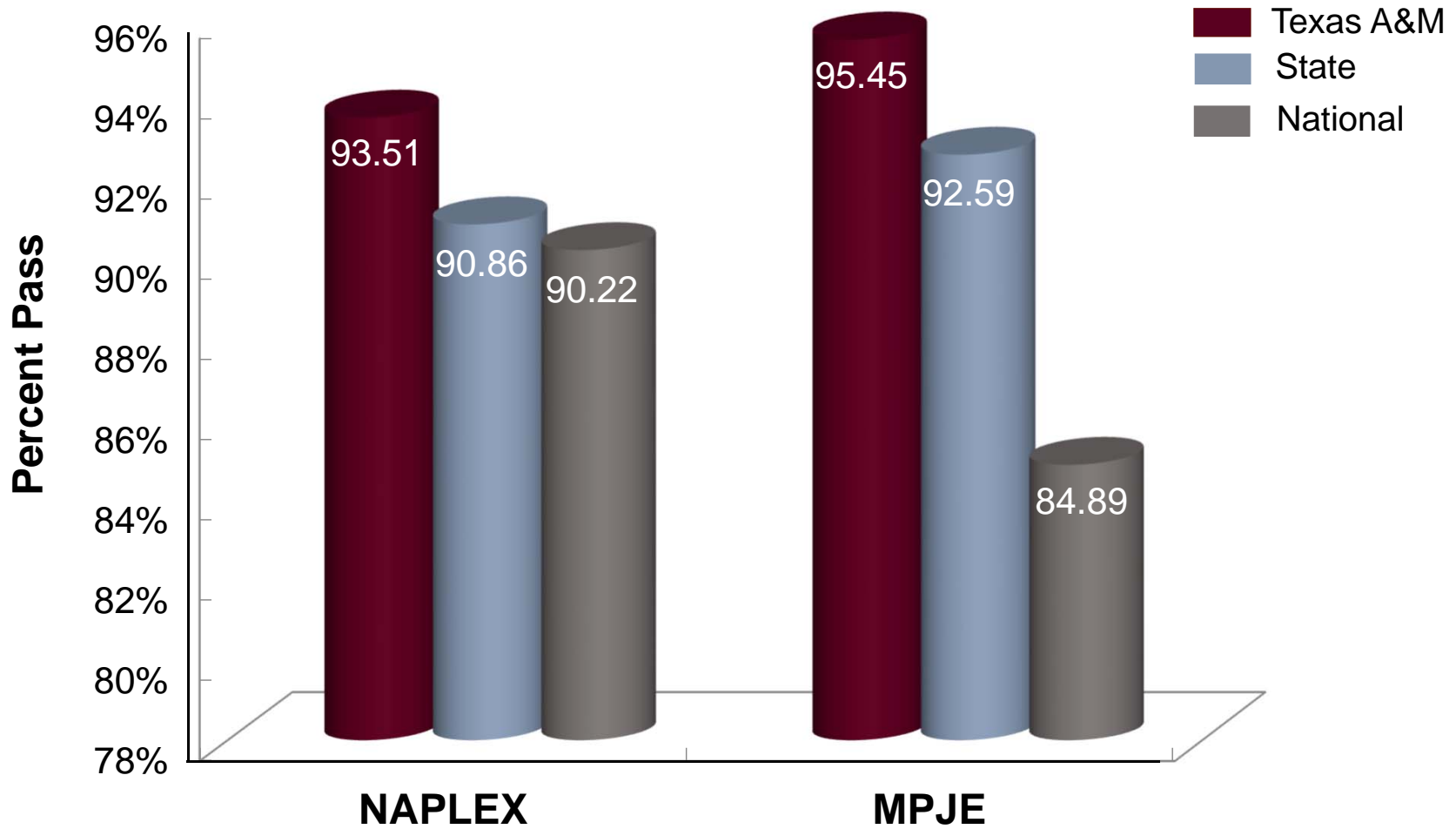
PHARMACY CURRICULUM OUTCOMES ASSESSMENT (PCOA)

PCOA Exam: Measure of P3 Student Achievement in 2016



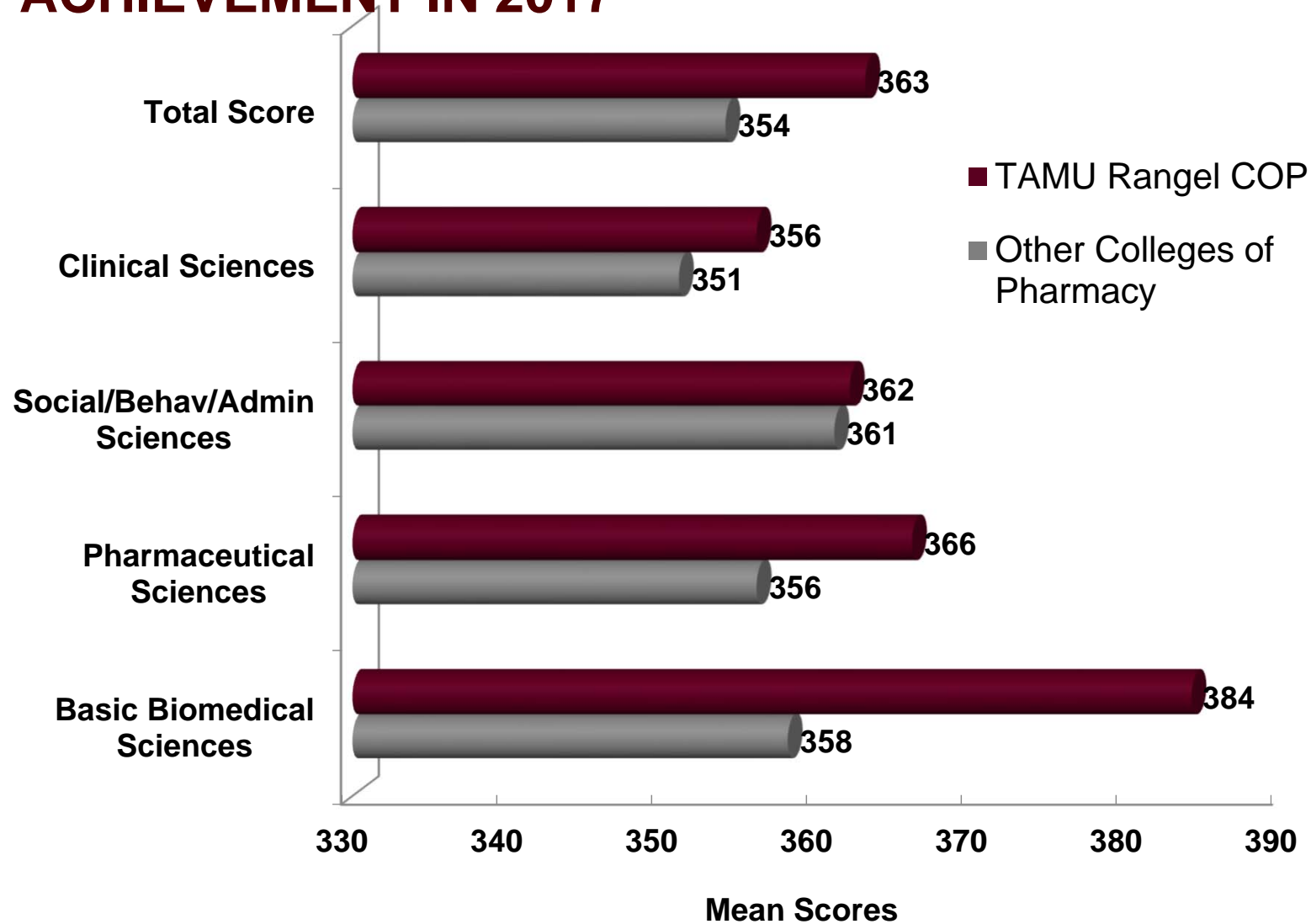


FIRST-TIME PASS RATES ON NAPLEX AND MPJE 2017

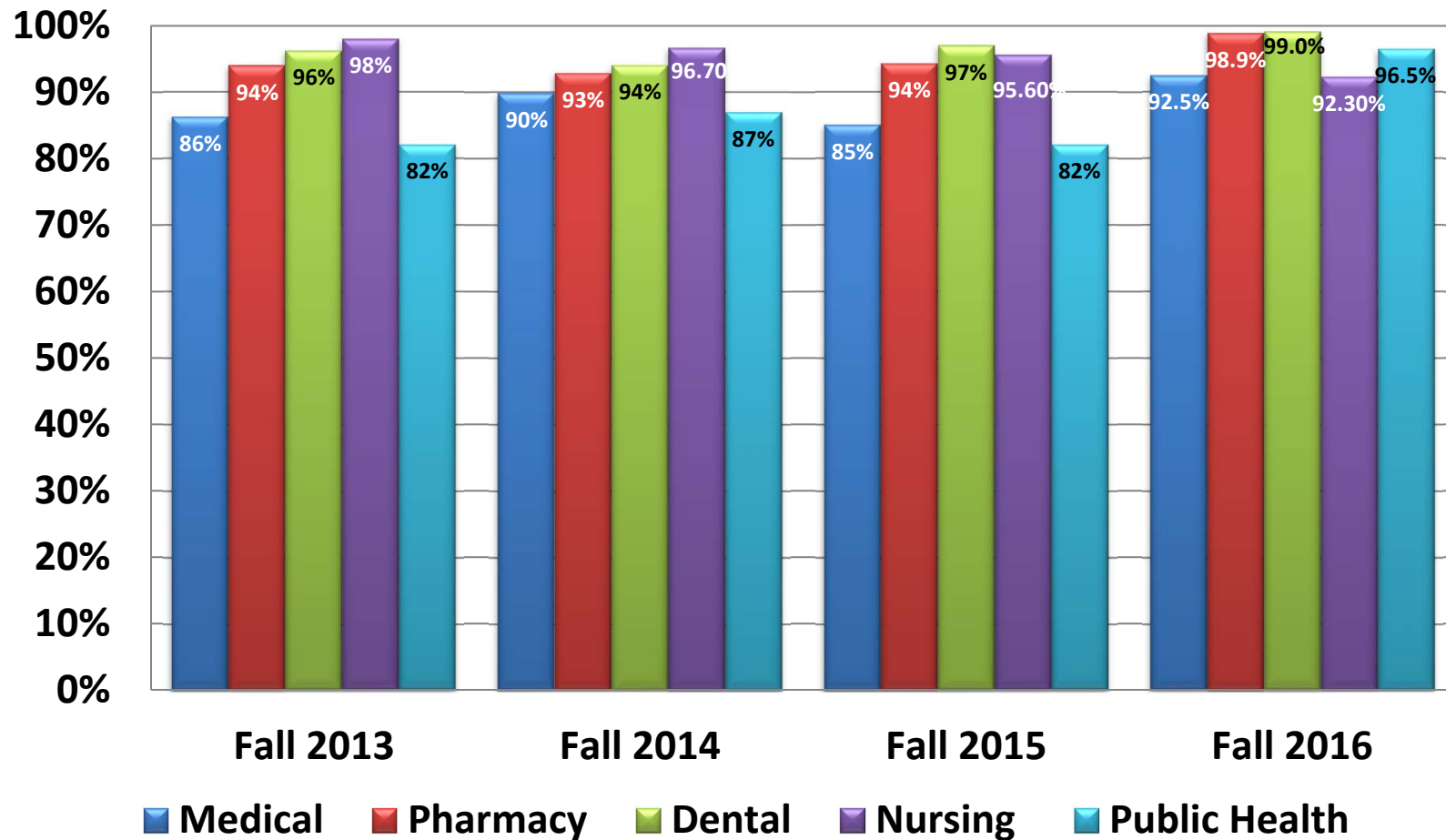
